California November 5, 2024	ACA 13	Very broadly, according to the sponsor of the measure, ACA 13 "simply requires a measure that seeks to raise a voter threshold to meet that same threshold. For example, if a measure seeks to raise a voter threshold to two-thirds, it must also pass by that margin." Colorado November 7, 2023	Colorado Proposition HH	A "yes" vote on Proposition HH lowers property taxes owed, allows the state to keep additional money that would otherwise be refunded to taxpayers, temporarily changes how taxpayer TABOR refunds are distributed, and creates a new property tax limit for most local governments. A "no" vote on Proposition HH maintains current law for property taxes, TABOR refunds, and state and local government revenue limits.
