Individual tuition includes accommodations (arrival Sunday, departure Thursday), all meals and daily snacks, materials, in-room internet and evening entertainment. For individuals who live in the Atlanta area and plan to commute each day to the conference, the commuter fee includes materials, evening activities, meals and parking – internet not included.

Spouses/Guests may register with COST to attend all food functions for \$240.

The school is open to tax professionals from industry (both COST member and non-COST member companies) and from practitioner firms.

NOTE: Cancellations for the Intermediate/Advanced State Income and Sales Tax Schools: There will be a 50% cancellation fee for cancellations received before 5:00 p.m. on April 1st. Cancellations received thereafter will not be refunded. *All cancellations/substitutions must be in writing.*

CONTINUING EDUCATION

COST will assist in applying for Continuing Education credit for the 2010 Intermediate/Advanced State Income and Sales Tax Schools. COST is registered with the National Association of State Boards of Accountancy (NASBA) as a sponsor of continuing professional education on the National Registry of CPE Sponsors. State boards of accountancy have the final authority on the acceptance of individual courses. Complaints regarding sponsors may be addressed to NASBA, 150 Fourth Avenue North, Suite 700, Nashville, Tennessee 37219-2414. Each course is tentatively approved for 23.5 CPE (50 min.) hours. There are no prerequisites for this school and the program level is intermediate. COST will also assist in securing CLE credits with state bar associations.

RESERVATIONS/ROOM INFORMATION

COST will make your hotel reservations for you. All reservations will be made with each attendee arriving on Sunday, April 25th and departing on Thursday, April 29th. The School registration fee includes the four nights. If you plan to arrive early or depart later, please inform COST as to your plans. Each additional night is \$139 plus taxes. Each individual will be responsible for payment upon check out of the hotel for the additional night(s).

The Georgia Tech Conference Center has 252 guestrooms. All rooms have high speed internet access, flat-screen TV's, private bathroom, irons and ironing boards, in-room coffee and tea service, room service, bath robes, and complimentary newspapers. Advanced fitness center and indoor pool are available to guests. Non-smoking and wheelchair accessible rooms are available. Check in time is 3:00 p.m. and check out is 11:00 a.m.

MEALS

All meals are included as part of your School registration fee, beginning with the dinner on Sunday, April 25th and concluding with lunch on Thursday, April 29th. (COST name badge must be worn.) Breakfast, lunch and dinner will be served in the conference dining room, which is open from 6:30 a.m. until 7:00 p.m. Snack service will be provided throughout the meeting area between 6:30 a.m. and 4:00 p.m. If lighter fare is preferred for breakfast, a continental breakfast is also served in these snack areas in the morning. Room service is available until 11:00 p.m. However, it is not included in the registration fee and will be applied to individual bills upon check out.
