Oakland, California	Measure T Progressive Business Tax III	Would amend Oakland's business tax rates to create a progressive rate structure that would: (1) impose the highest rates on the highest grossing businesses; (2) increase Oakland's annual tax revenue by an estimated \$20,900,000; and (3) generate approximately \$124,000,000 in total annual revenue for municipal services by imposing business tax rates of .05 percent to .55 percent of gross receipts (and other rates as stated in the measure).
